



## Rosie Eudora Bacon

March 7, 1936 - May 28, 2012

Mother Rosie Eudora Bacon (Dora) was born on March 7, 1936 in Dawson, GA to Eugene and Estelle Salter (deceased). She was the second child of ten children. She attended public schools in Dawson where she graduated from Carver High School in 1955. She left Dawson and went north to New Jersey, where she met and married John Bacon Sr. they enjoyed 43 years of matrimony, until his death in 2002. They raised their 4 children to be God-fearing, where they all became members of White Rock Baptist Church (Linden, NJ), in their youth. Mother Bacon was invited to attend a singing concert at Morning Star United Holiness Church (Linden, NJ) in mid-70, where she gave her life to the Lord. She was a strong woman and a very devoted worker in the home and in her personal work experience. She displayed immense love to her immediate and extended family members, and she touched many lives during her journey with her words of wisdom and her beautiful smile. She was pre-deceased by her youngest son Vincent Bacon

and her sister Marian Salter in 1992.
