Ms. Sallie Patricia Sledge, age 71, of Jonesboro, GA passed Thursday, March 25, 2021. Sallie Patricia Sledge (named after her mother and a maternal aunt) was born in Warren County NC to the late Sallie B and George H.W. Sledge. She was raised and educated in Washington, DC and graduated from Anacostia Senior High in 1966. After graduation, she attended Lincoln University in PA and proudly represented the class of 1970.

Sallie married, had kids, and acquired additional family and friends while living and working in DC, PA, Columbus GA, Hampton VA, Jacksonville, FL, and Atlanta, GA. She held two careers, first as a youth counselor, and later in customer service, retiring from Sprint in 2015. Sallie was an avid reader and was well known for her sharp wit and straight-shooting demeanor. She loved to socialize and never knew a stranger which blessed her with an abundance of friends who became family.

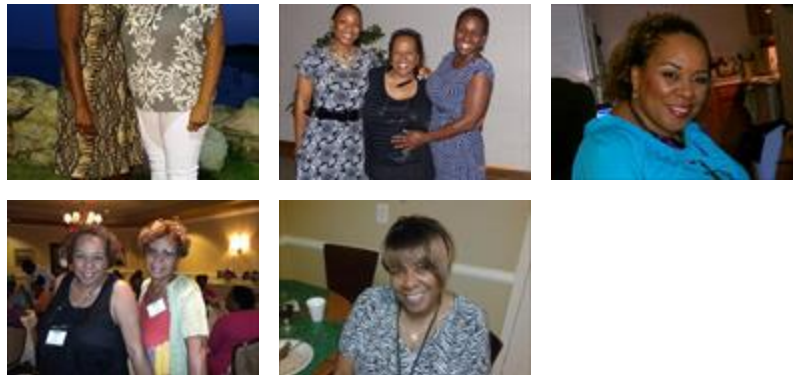
