Samuel Johnson Long was born on September 9, 1964, to James Long and Yvonne (Soules) Long in Indianapolis, Indiana. He was the third son of the couple's seven children and the fourth child of his father.

After graduating from high school, he attended ITT Technical Institute, where he obtained his associate's degree. He then enlisted in the United States Navy and served for seven and a half years as a mechanic on Navy aircraft. Stationed in San Diego, California, he served during the Gulf War Era and peacetime until October 1991.

After leaving the Navy, Sammy, as he was known to his family and friends, relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, to join his brother Harold. Soon their younger brother Jeffrey joined them, and the three brothers ran the city. He worked for Delta Airlines, FedEx, and Robins Air Force Base while also pursuing entrepreneurial endeavors.

Sammy fulfilled one of his father's dreams for his family by traveling the world, having visited most of the continents. Like his father, he too studied many cultures and faiths, including the teachings of Elijah Muhammad and Louis Farrakhan. He loved debating religion and politics and was often found smiling and making jokes.

Samuel departed this earth on January 8, 2025, leaving behind his beloved wife Marie Djapta; his two sons: Antwone Williams (Indianapolis), Elijah Long (Atlanta); Charly Guentio (Atlanta); granddaughter, Iyanna Williams; great-grandson, La Quan Johnson Jr.; sisters, Angela Trammell (Mark) and Lisa

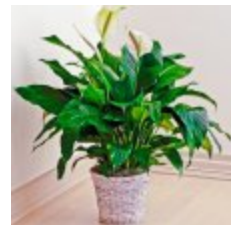
