Mrs. Sara Louise Edmondson, age 81, peacefully entered eternal rest on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, surrounded by the love and presence of her family. Her life was a beautiful testament to faith, service, and unwavering devotion to those she loved.

Sara was born on February 20, 1945, in Anniston, Alabama, to the late Mr. James Rufus Howell and Mrs. Annie Laura Howell. She was the fourth of nine children, growing up in a close-knit family that instilled in her the values of resilience, compassion, and faith that would guide her throughout her life.

She attended Anniston public schools and proudly graduated from Cobb High School in the Class of 1963. During her school years, Sara was selected to play the clarinet in the band, but with her vibrant spirit, she chose instead to shine as a majorette.

In 2006, Sara relocated to Duluth, Georgia, where she continued her life of service as an Administrative Assistant at New Life Academy of Excellence School, impacting the lives of students and staff alike with her warmth and dedication.
