Later, she began working for Dekalb Medical Hillandale in 2001, and when the hospital opened in 2005, she became the supervisor of emergency services. By 2022, she had advanced to managing both emergency and outpatient services. Throughout her leadership, she inspired many through her mentorship, encouraging words, and vision. Shavon was a beacon of kindness, generosity, and compassion.

Her willingness to go above and beyond, along with her memorable laugh and positive energy, brightened the days of those around her and left a lasting impact on everyone who had the privilege of working with her. She will be missed by all who knew her.
