On April 20, 1947 at 6:47 a.m., in Windsor, Ontario, Canada, Bishop Arthur and Sylvia Harrison gave birth to their 11th child whom they named Sheila Yvonne. After completing her high school education in Windsor, Sheila went on to earn her Bachelors Degree in Business Administration from Madonna College in Detroit, Michigan. She was employed for 20 years at the Inkster Board of Education.

She married and had two children Sheillon and Rod Lumpkin, II. In 1986, Sheila moved to Atlanta Georgia where she worked for 15 years as a Regional Supervisor for Sprint. After retiring from Sprint, Sheila used her administrative skills as facilitator for the Gwinnett Juvenile Court Programs and to help develop a charter school in Atlanta.

Sheila loved God and was a faithful and active church member. For the past six years she was a member of Dayspring International Worship Center in Stone Mountain, GA, where she served as Chief Financial Officer. Whenever the doors of the church opened, she was there; both on Sundays and on weekdays.
