Shirley loved cooking and making big meals for her family. She loved reading and was always willing to share a book or two with you. After graduating from school she moved to New York she attended many churches.

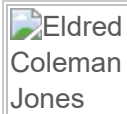
She always called on the saints of God for prayer in times of trouble. Later in life, Shirley returned to her hometown of Sidon,, MS.
