Stanford Godfrey Wallace of Chapelton Clarendon, Jamaica transitioned on Thursday, January 12, 2023. After several months of declining health, Stanford died peacefully with his beloved wife Jenetta by his side.

Stanford was the youngest of three children born to Albert Wallace and Estella Bailey in Clarendon Jamaica. He became an Entrepreneur in his early years, owning multiple businesses throughout his life.
