Tamara Racquel Tuitt-Bartlett, affectionately known by her family as “Tammy,” was born on June 24, 1976, in Miami, Florida, to Sarah Virginia Martin and Larry Emanuel Ross. From the very beginning, Tammy was full of energy, laughter, and a natural curiosity that lit up every room she entered.

Tamara’s early education began at Buena Vista Elementary School in Miami, continued at Lake Stevens Middle School in Miami Gardens, and culminated with her proud graduation from Carol City High School. Even as a young girl, she aspired to become a detective, a dream that reflected her deep curiosity, strong sense of justice, and unwavering determination. She pursued that calling by earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Johnson & Wales University in Miami.

Tammy’s greatest joy in life was her family. She welcomed her first son, Stephon, and later met and married the love of her life, the late Richard Bartlett, Jr. Together, they built a home filled with love, laughter, and purpose. Their union was blessed with two wonderful sons, the late Richard Bartlett III and Jared, in Miami, and in 2009, their youngest son, Jaeden, arrived to complete their beautiful family. Tammy’s devotion to her children knew no

In 2002, Tamara and her family relocated to Georgia, where she pursued her passion for public service. She joined the Gwinnett County Sheriff's Office, where she honorably served as a Master Deputy Sheriff for approximately 20 years. She took great pride in serving her community, protecting others, and standing up for those who could not stand up for themselves.

Outside of work, Tammy was the heartbeat of every gathering. She loved traveling, spending time with friends, and visiting family across Florida, New York, and California. 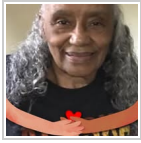

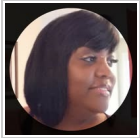
