Tamika Yvette Williams was born in Philadelphia PA and passed away on August 28th, 2024, in Austell GA.

Tamika was raised in the Philadelphia area, graduating from Coatesville Area Senior High (CASH) in 1988. After graduating from CASH, Tamika began working at Lukens Steel, where she was a plate grinder and laboratory technician.

In 1990, Tamika met John Williams, who also worked at Lukens. They began a lifetime relationship that led to their marriage in 1998. Subsequently, the family moved to Columbus Ohio, Norfolk Virginia and finally Atlanta Georgia. At each location, Tamika became a focal point of the community, volunteering countless hours in the local school systems, invigorating the social scene of each neighborhood, and supporting the family while meeting the unique challenges of being an Army wife. Along the way, Tamika completed her certification as an Exercise Specialist from the Sport & Fitness Management Program from Columbus State College and worked for New Manchester Elementary School as a Media Center Specialist.

Her true passion was developing and supporting children. The children at New Manchester Elementary maintained a special place in her heart but she truly loved all her nieces, nephews and cousins – to her this included all the children of her family members and friends!

Tamika and John were blessed with three fantastic and remarkable children; Wastell (Duder), Angela (Angel) and John (lil John). She is survived by her forever loving husband, three children, her mother and father, three brothers, three sisters, numerous nephews and nieces and countless friends.

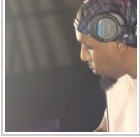
