After moving to Atlanta he became of long time member of West Mitchell Street CME Church. During his membership he served as Chairman of the Steward Board for several years and appointed Steward Emeritus, Sunday School Teacher, Male Chorus Member, Senior Birthday Ministry and he volunteered with the Church Parking Lot Attendant Ministry for the Falcons Football Games.

Profession & Vocation – Terry L. Allen was employed by the Fulton County

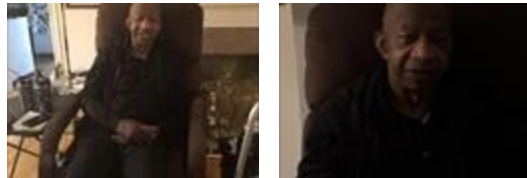
