Terolyn, and finally Jamall. After retiring from New York Telephone Company, the empty nesters, Terry and Mildred, were motivated to move south too. They purchased another house in Snellville, Georgia. That's where all of the pieces came together. Terry joined Salem Missionary Baptist Church, in Lilburn, Georgia where he continued to demonstrate his love for God. He could not do enough for the church. He drove the church bus for the seniors, was honored to serve as an Usher, a Deacon, and volunteered to complete church tasks whenever and wherever he could.

He volunteered at the Eastside Medical Center where he worked as a Concierge Attendant and played Santa Claus for the kids during Christmas time.

The house in Snellville would be the place chosen for Terry's last breath on this earth, Saturday, July 25th, 2020. He was surrounded by loving family and friends. Family, friends, and church members called us to offer words of encouragement and sympathies.

Terry Brown loved: his wife, his children, his grandchildren, his great grandchildren, his music, caramel cake, to laugh, to give gifts, to help and support others, his church family and our God.
