Thomas Matthew Norman Jr., known affectionately as "Junebug", was born August 29, 1935 to the late Deacon Thomas Matthew Norman Sr. and Mother Pearlie Lee Hinton Norman.

He attended Dekalb County's Avondale Colored School and Hamilton High School in Scottdale Georgia.

As a young boy he was always interested in automobiles and would watch the neighborhood mechanic as he worked on cars. Several years of his work life was spent working on cars. An exceptional driver and a fast driver, he was often summoned to drive relatives and friends on long trips. He enjoyed the fast lane, even back in the day when roads had only one lane.

Thomas retired from the DeKalb County School System. He established and maintained many life-long personal relationships during his career.

He attended the Travelers Rest Baptist Church in Scottdale Georgia and served diligently on the Board of Ushers. He had a no-nonsense approach to his duties and was a dedicated doorkeeper.

Thomas took pride in his strong family heritage and he enjoyed the fellowship with his relatives in the
