Deacon Tommy Mosley Jr. was born November 30, 1955 in (Banks) Pike County, Alabama. He was the youngest child of the late Elder Tommie Mosley and Bishop Mary Q. Mosley-Byrd. He was predeceased by an older brother – James Long.

Tommy was educated through the Pike County School System where he excelled in a variety of sports.

At an early age, Tommy became a member of the Church of the Living God – The Pillar and Ground of the Truth – Which He Purchased with His Own Blood, Inc. Jewell Dominion. 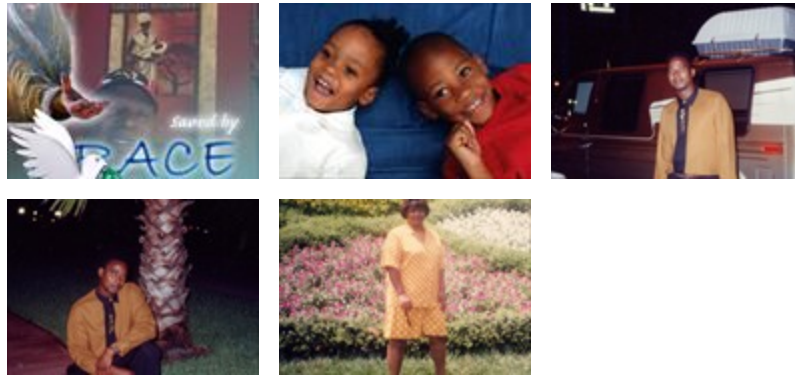
