She peacefully transitioned on July 11, 2025.

Born and raised in Baltimore, Maryland, Tonya graduated from Edgewood High School in 1981.

She went on to earn her associate degree from the Community College of Baltimore County in

1986. From there, she began her journey of discovering the career path that best suited her.

Alongside her mother, Shirley Greene, she opened a floral arrangement business. She later

worked for the FDIC and eventually found her professional home at the Centers for Disease

Control and Prevention (CDC), where she built a meaningful career. After 41 years of dedicated

service to the U.S. federal government, she retired in May 2025.

If Tonya wasn't out shopping for her next Coach bag, she was likely hopping on a flight to her

next passport stamp. You could also find her bowling with friends or stretched out on a beach,

soaking up the sun. She was a great rummy partner and an even better travel

buddy.

She is survived by her siblings: Thomas, Thiyon, and Namia; her nephew, Zaki; and her great niece, Amiyah. Tonya also leaves behind a host of dear friends who became more like sisters over the years.

She was a daughter, an aunt, a sister, a grandmother, a second mother, and anything else God called her to be.
