Victor Carlisle Howell was born on October 30, 1943, and transitioned to be with the Lord on February 3, 2021, he was 78. Victor was born to parents Doris Stoute and Phitz-Leonard Howell in St. Michaels, Barbados. He was the oldest of three boys, Ricardo 'Michael' Howell, who preceded him in death, and Peter Alan Howell, are his brothers.

Victor was raised in Barbados and graduated high school at The Lodge in his hometown. In 1961 he came to the United States, and initially made New York his home. He obtained an undergraduate degree at The New York University, and a Master's in Business Administration from St. Johns University. Upon receiving his Masters Degree he briefly sold stock on Wall Street for Merrill Lynch, however, he did not like the confinement of an office and sought out for something different. He then began working at Dow Corning Chemical Corporation where he started in Sales, and eventually became a Marketing Manager/Executive. He worked for Dow Corning for over 20 years, and in several locations such as, St. Louis, Missouri, Atlanta, Georgia, Midland, Michigan, and Lake Mary, Florida. In 1985 Victor became a proud member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated, Pi Pi Chapter. His most recent fraternal association was with the Chi Gamma Gamma Chapter.

During the course of his life Victor had many hobbies. In his early years he was an avid golfer, winning many trophies in local tournaments, and was quite the cricket player. He enjoyed playing tennis and was an excellent cook. In the later years he enjoyed traveling back and forth between the States and

Barbados where he loved to spend time with friends and family playing dominoes and cards.

In addition to his love of life, he loved the Lord, and was a member of St. Michaels and All Angels at the time of his death. Victor was a man of God and exuded that in everything he did, especially as it relates to his family. Victor had two daughters, Nicole Andrea Howell, who preceded him death, and Kristin Allene Howell. He has two grandsons Derrick Vaughn Henderson, II, and Nicholas Tee Edwards. He was a Beloved, and Proud, Father and Grandfather who did everything for is family. He was a provider, a protector, and a nurturer. He will be truly missed by all those who knew him.

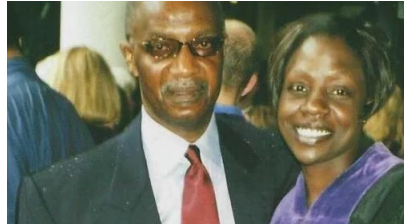
