In 1984 the family moved to Atlanta where he attended Hapeville Middle School and graduated from Tri City High School.

He also loved athletics, bowling, skiing, and participated on the Special Olympics track and field team rendering him numerous first and second prize medals. He played basketball on his school team. In earlier years he was involved in the lives of his younger nieces Eryn and Camille lighting up their days visiting Stone Mountain Beach; hanging out the community pool, and participating in various activities. He always looked out for them ensuring their safety.
