On January 14, 1941, Vivian Deloris Young Boone was born to Henry and Mary Young in Excelsior, West Virginia. She was the fourth of twelve children. Vivian passed from this life on February 21, 2023, at the blessed age of 82 in the state of Georgia.

Vivian relocated to Boston, Massachusetts after leaving West Virginia in 1959, where she married Edward Boone. Their union produced three children — Kenneth, Edwin, and Calvin.

Vivian studied Accounting at Boston Business School in 1970 and 1971.

Later, Vivian joined her nephew Darrell Young's church, Lively Stones Christian Center in Abington. At Lively Stones, Vivian taught Sunday School. She enjoyed communing with fellow worshippers and attended many bus trips sponsored by the church.

Vivian is survived by her sons, Kenneth, Edwin, and Calvin; daughters-in-law, Rozaan and Amma; grandchildren, Starlyn, Ian, Vanessa, Ohema, David, Horus, Aliya, Ausar and Savion; great-grandchildren, Zanaiyah, Thomas III, Taniya, Jermaine, Ian Jr., and Jamir; brothers, Henry Young, Harry Young, and Franklyn Young; sisters, Yvonne Ferguson, Alice Edwards and Dawne Mills, and a host of nieces and nephews.
