



## Warren Morgan II

October 3, 1953 - March 13, 2020

Mr. Warren H. Morgan, II, 66 years of age, passed on Friday, March 13, 2020 at Kennestone Hospital, Marietta, GA. Warren was born October 3, 1953 in Chicago, Illinois, to the late Warren H. Morgan, Sr., and Kathryn Banks. He was the oldest of 5 siblings.

Warren attended John Marshall Harlan Community Academy on the south side of Chicago. He graduated from Eureka College in Eureka, Illinois with a concentration in Business Administration Management. Warren relocated his family to Atlanta, Georgia in 1988. Warren's life was filled with many extraordinary accomplishments. Among the greatest was his marriage to Sharolyn Square Morgan on August 18, 2018, blending two families into one.
