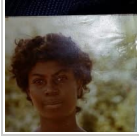

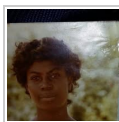

Thanks be to God myself and Abayomi had the opportunity seeing you for the last time at the hospital. Throughout our lives any questions I had you answered them, now my question is why, why my brother and you can't answer me. 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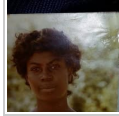
