After graduating from high school, William continued his education matriculating at Tuskegee Institute (now Tuskegee University), where he earned a degree in African American History. As a young adult, William enjoyed working with young people, serving as both a Little League baseball coach and a high school football coach.

On September 8, 1984, William married the love of his life, Carolyn D. Conner. Together, they shared 41 years of marriage, living a life of adventure, traveling throughout the country and abroad.

Professionally, William was an award-winning college recruiter for DeVry University and other technical institutions. He took great pride in helping students take their first steps toward higher education and meaningful careers.

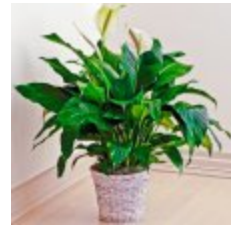

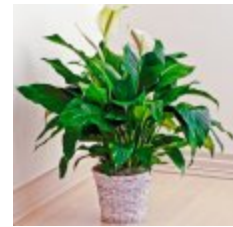
