



## William James Rutland, Jr.

William James Rutland, affectionately known as “Man” and later “Bill,” departed this life on July 2, 2025, at the age of 95. He was a cherished husband, stepfather, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, brother-in-law, uncle, cousin and friend. He now rests in the loving embrace of Jesus along with his wife, Luella Rutland; parents, William and Freddie Mae Rutland; his brother, Freddie Rutland; his sister, Mary Alice Watts; stepson and stepdaughter, Ronald Lynn Ellis and Valerie Denise Smith and great-granddaughter, Serenity Danielle Ellis.

Born on May 18, 1930, in Barnesville, Georgia, Bill lived a life enriched with purpose, passion and love. Shortly after his birth, his parents moved the family to Winter Garden, Florida. At a young age, Bill started working at an orange grove. Later, he and his father were the only two African Americans that worked for a major milk dairy.

In 1954, he migrated to Buffalo, New York where he obtained a job at Western Electric Corporation. During the 1960’s, Bill acquired a Master Barber’s License to subsequently own a premier barbershop in Buffalo, while simultaneously working at Western Electric.

During the summer of 1971, Bill met Luella Ellis. He later proposed to her, and they wed on March 27, 1976. That same year, Western Electric was

purchased by the AT&T Corporation, and he was transferred to one of their facilities in Atlanta, Georgia. Soon thereafter, He and Luella made a strong commitment to dedicating their lives to serving the Lord. Together, they enjoyed a happy and fruitful life until he retired in 1990 and long afterwards.

A dedicated and skilled worker, Bill was known as a “jack of all trades”, earning him the admiration of many for his knowledge and ability to operate and repair machinery on the job. His resourcefulness and integrity made him a valuable figure to be praised.

Bill’s vibrant personality was demonstrated through his love for life’s simple pleasures. He had a deep appreciation for gardening and found joy in every moment of it.

A man of unwavering love, Bill shared 46 years of marriage with his devoted wife Luella. He is survived by his sister Frances Jones, stepson Danny Ellis, daughters-in-law Jacqueline Ellis and Melody Ellis, nine grandchildren, six great grandchildren and extended family of nephews, nieces, cousins and friends.

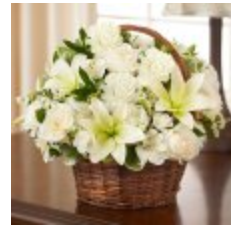
