OBITUARY

Willie Harrison Bailey, Jr., entered this world on April 3, 1975, as the first-born son to Willie and Antoinette Bailey in Atlanta, GA. He was a man of many names, such as “Bailo” and “Harrison,” but beneath these names was the same humble and loving man who touched so many of us with his humor, kindness, generosity, and love. He was a son, brother, husband, and father who left us too soon on January 17, 2025, leaving an irreplaceable void in the hearts of all of us.

EARLY LIFE AND EDUCATION

Born in Atlanta, GA, he spent his pre-college years in the Atlanta and Lithonia areas with his parents and his younger brother Darryl. He attended Lithonia High School in Lithonia, GA and played as a defensive back on the varsity football team (#64). After graduating from Lithonia in 1993, he left Georgia to attend Cumberland University in Lebanon, TN where he played as a proud Cumberland Patriot linebacker and defensive end (#46). While at Cumberland, he made several lifelong friends who became like brothers to him: Walter Banks (“Banks”), Reginald Gibson (“Gip”), Chad Harvey (“Big Chad”), and Steve McClain (“Boat”). He graduated in 1997 from Cumberland with dual degrees in Psychology and Criminal Justice—making him the first person in the Bailey family to graduate from college.

CAREER AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

After graduating from Cumberland, Harrison returned to Atlanta and served for

a brief period of time as a Dekalb County police officer. He did not stay long with the police force as entrepreneurship was his calling, so he left the police force to start a corporate relocations company called Phoenix Relocations. After more than 10 years of managing and physically working with Phoenix Relocations alongside his Uncle Ed, he realized that it was far easier work using his mind instead of his back. Thus, he enrolled in college to earn a bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering from Kennesaw State University and worked with a few different companies thereafter utilizing his engineering degree.

FAMILY LIFE

On July 7, 2007, Harrison married Bonita Reynolds at Emory Conference Center in Atlanta. A couple of years after marriage, they had Madison Lauren in 2009, followed by son, Harrison Grant, in 2014. He enjoyed watching football, was known for his skills on the grill, occasional golf, and was always ready to take a trip to anywhere there was a beach.

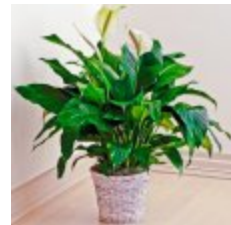
