### Obituary

Mr. Willie Clarence Roberts was born July 26, 1948 in Atlanta, Georgia to the late R. H. & Inez Roberts. He peacefully departed this life in the comfort of his home on June 25, 2022.

Willie attended Cooper Street Elementary and graduated from Luther Judson Price High School in 1966; while there he identified his athleticism and accelerated on the football and track teams. Right after high school, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corp on June 14, 1966. During his service as a Marine, he completed basic training at Parris Island, SC, and advanced training at Camp Lejeune, NC & Camp Pendelton, CA. He received one of the highest recognizable awards in the US armed forces, the "Purple Heart" for valor in the line of duty while serving in the Vietnam War. In addition to the Purple Heart, he received many other accolades: Presidential Citation,

National Defense Medal, Vietnamese Service Medal, Vietnamese Campaign Medal, & a Combat Action ribbon. After his time overseas, he worked for the US Postal Service and as a Maintenance Technician.
