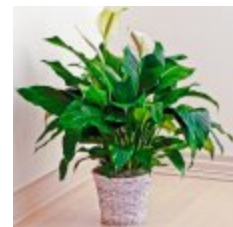

“ In 2015, Winston told me (Delanyard) and our middle brother (Alonford) that he had a “leading” to encourage us three Robinson brothers to write a book about our childhood: “Three Robinson Brothers: Winston, Alonford and Delanyard.”

Several rough drafts have been written since that time. Hopefully, an updated draft will be completed and published by March 2027. Here (in tribute to Winston) is an excerpt that partially describes a few of his numerous character strengths:

“Winston, whom I often referred to as “Melvis/Meg” during our childhood, is my youngest brother. He absolutely floored me with his intelligence, wit and mastery of words! No wonder he is a Gospel Minister and Teacher! Teaching seemed to have been, and continues to be one of his passions. During these past years we talked at length about life’s issues. I am always awed by the depth and inspiration that came out of the exchanges/conversations we enjoyed. I often think (and have held such thought over the years): “Awesome!” That term is an accurate characterization of Winston. I am certain you would agree if you had the privilege of being at the foot of his teaching! By the way, Alonford (“Son”) is like that too! What happened to me?” (Delanyard, 2017)

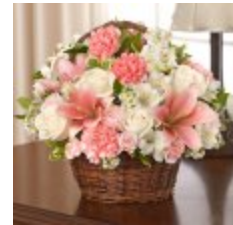

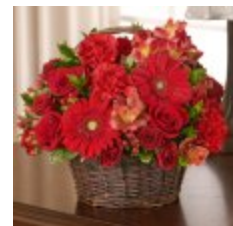
