He was an amazing, inquisitive, and loving child with a jovial spirit. Full of energy and constantly moving. Xavia was an avid athlete playing basketball, baseball, football, swimming, gymnastics, and soccer. His maternal grandfather, Luther Anthony, was his best

friend and mentor. It’s through this relationship that Xavia found an appreciation for golf.

Xavia was a creative soul. Talented in drawing and passionate about his music. Xavia could look at a picture and recreate it with detail.
