



Yvette Osei Kwarteng Maame Yaa

March 27, 1975 - January 26, 2022

Yvette Osei Kwarteng, also known as Maame Yaa, was born in Asafo in the Subin municipality to the late Mr. and Mrs. Osei Kwarteng on March 27th, 1975. Maame Yaa was the second of six children. She began her education at the age of six at Armed Force Garrison Primary School in Adum, a suburb of Kumasi. Afterwards, she attended Martyrs of Uganda JSS and completed the GCE Ordinary and Advanced levels at Technology Secondary School, popularly known as TECHSEC in 1996. In October 1994, she had her first and only child Demetra. She worked in communications until leaving Ghana for England in 2004 in search of greener pastures to help care for her parents and younger siblings.

She lived in England from 2004 until 2020. She loved to help others and spent her career doing so. In England, she worked as a health and social care worker helping to care for adults with mental illness. She also worked with troubled children and worked as a caregiver for adults with disabilities. In July 2020, she moved to Atlanta, Georgia to be closer to her daughter. They lived together in the United States where she worked as a caregiver and as a nanny. Her employers spoke highly of her work ethic, kindness and enthusiasm. She won Best Caregiver Award from her caregiving agency in May 2021.

She was a loving mother, a caring sister, a wonderful aunt, a loyal friend, and

a devoted child of God. She was a beautiful woman inside and out. She loved life and she was on fire for God! The first thing she would do when she woke up was play gospel music. She prayed day and night, and shared devotionals with her daughter every night. She was an amazing cook and took time to make her dishes with care and heart. She was a fashionista and enjoyed shopping. She liked to capture moments with pictures and videos. She was loving, dependable, encouraging and gave great advice. She was a joy to be around. Maame Yaa, you made a lasting impact on the lives of your family and loved ones. You are forever loved and forever missed. Until we reunite again, rest well in heaven.
